Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Bangalore

Upon arrival at Bangalore airport/ railway station our representative will help you take a transfer to hotel. Afternoon proceed for sightseeing of Bangalore - The Lal bagh, Cubbon park, Vidhana Soudha, Bangalore palace, Tipu Sultan's palace, Bull temple, St. Patrick's church and other highlights of the city are covered in this trip.. Overnight stay in Bangalore.

Day 02 : Bangalore to Mysore

Morning after breakfast check out hotel and proceed to Mysore. Upon arrival check-in hotel. Later proceed for sightseeing of Mysore –visit The Brindavan Gardens, Mysore Palace, Chamundi Hills, Mysore Lake, Zoo, St. Philomena's Church and many more highlights of this ancient city in covered in this trip.. Overnight stay in Mysore.

Day 03: Mysore to Wayanad

Morning after breakfast our representative and transfer you to Wayanad, exclusively called as the "Green Paradise" of Kerala is nestled among the mountains of the Western Ghats, sharing the border with Tamil Nadu and Karnataka This verdant hill station is full of plantations, forest and wildlife. Upon arrival you will be transferred to the hotel. . Evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Wayanad.

Day 04: Wayanad

In the morning after breakfast, start the sightseeing covering the pookkoda lake, lakkadi, kuruva island, edakkal cave and the fast flowing rivers panavaram river, mananthavadi river and kabini river. Overnight stay in wayanad.

Day 05: Wayanad to Cochin

Morning after breakfast check out from the hotel/Resort and proceed to Cochin. Check-in to the hotel on arrival and relax. Evening is free at leisure. Overnight stay in Cochin.

Day 06: Cochin

Morning after breakfast visit Chinese Fishing Nets, St. Francis Church, Jewish Synagogue the Dutch Palace. In the evening, enjoy boat cruise(at own cost) in the beautiful port city of Cochin. Overnight stay in Cochin.

Day 07: Cochin to Munnar

Morning after breakfast you will be transferred to Munnar.. Munnar is located at the confluence of 03 rivers as the very name signifies. The sprawling tea plantations and picturesque towns make Munnar a popular hill resort town in South India. Enroute visit Cheyyapra waterfalls, Valara waterfalls, Attukadu waterfalls, Spice plantations etc. On your arrival at Munnar you will be transferred to the hotel. . Evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Munnar.

Day 08: Munnar

In the morning after breakfast, start the sightseeing of Munnar visiting the tea plantations, Tea Museum, the Eravikulam National park home of the endangered Niligiri Thar (Ibex), followed by visit to the Mattupetty dam, the the Kundala Lake and other scenic spots. Overnight stay at the Hotel.

Day 09: Munnar to Thekkady (120 Kms / 4 Hrs)

Morning after breakfast transfer to Thekkady. Thekkady has one of the world's most fascinating natural wildlife reserves noted for its geography, diverse wildlife and scenic beauty. Arrive Thekkady and check-in at Hotel. Later afternoon boat ride on the Lake Periyar where one can have a unique experience of viewing wildlife at close quarters from the safety of a boat on the lake. The greatest attraction of Periyar, however are the herds of wild elephants that come down to play in the lake (Wild life viewing is always dependent on one's good fortune). Overnight stay at thekkady.

Day 10 : Thekkady to Alleppey (145 Kms / 4 Hrs)

Morning after breakfast check out and proceed to Alleppey. Alappuzha or, erstwhile Alleppey is a true splendour of Kerala. It is a tiny district of Kerala and looks like the place that has come straight from God's own paintbrush. Often deemed as the 'Venice of East' by many travelers. , this backwater state is also home to diverse range of animals and birds. Alleppey is simply the most magical place on the earth. On your arrival, you will be transferred to the resort. Houseboat. If you opt for the House Boat which is world's major tourist attraction you can relax while the boat cruises through the narrow serene backwater canals of Alleppey. We can see here in breathing green, the village slumbers by the Vembanad Lake. On cruise scenery flashes up vivid contrasts of lush green and deep blues. As the boat glider along the gorgeous green of the fringed palms the ripples in the blue water blend in to little wavelets. Lunch, Evening Tea/ Coffee with snacks, dinner all are provided inside the houseboat. Overnight stay will provide on House Boat. Note: • The cruise commences at 1230 hrs with lunch served on board and continues till dusk. At dusk the boat will anchor in a wide waterway or lake for the night (The backwaters close to boat traffic at dusk as the fisherman lay their nets in the backwaters. Other boats are not allowed to ply in the backwaters after dusk. On the following day the cruise commences again after breakfast and the guest will be dropped at Alleppey by 0900Hrs. Overnight stay at Houseboat. • Houseboat check in at 12Noon and cruises till 5PM, Boat will be anchored till 8AM and cruises till 9AM for checkout • For A/C Houseboat, A/C will be operating from 9PM till 6AM only (All houseboat related inclusions are applicable only if the Itinerary is including Houseboat stay) • Cruise Time : 6 hrs. • Bed Rooms : 01, 02 or 03 Bedroom as per room occupancy • Boarding @ : 12.00 pm •
