An attached pantry with each coach helps provide beverages and refreshments to the accompaniment of soothing music.

Attached to it are two restaurant compartments, Maharaja and Maharani respectively, with sumptuous draped curtains, elegantly crafted lights and table settings. The train journey begins from Safdarjung Railway Station New Delhi on a week-long run through

Rajasthan every Wednesday night, with a trip inbuilt to Agra, home to the iconic Taj Mahal. Turban-wearing stewards take over from the moment you arrive at the platform, assigning you your couples and detailing all the facilities that are on board. The train moves by night and arrives each morning at a new destination where new experiences wait for you.

- 2200 HRS: Returning to Palace on Wheels for onward journey to Sawai Madhopur.

### Day 3: Sawai Madhopur / Chittorgarh (Friday)

- 0915 HRS: Breakfast at a forest lodge.
- 1000 HRS: Return to Palace on Wheels
- 1030 HRS: A departing journey to Chittorgarh

- 1600 HRS: Arrival at Chittorgarh.
- 1630 HRS: A sightseeing tour to the Chittorgarh Fort.

- At the time of confirming the booking pay 25% of ticket value.
- 60 days prior to departure pay the remaining 75% of ticket value.
- A few of the significant specifics on the tariff of the Palace on Wheels are as:
- A surcharge is to be levied on all Christmas and New Year departures (25th December and 1st January respectively).
- 5% Service Tax will be charged extra.
- 10% of the tariff (without beds) for children less than 5 years.
- 50% of the tariff for children between 5 and 12 years.
- In case of No Show / Non-arrival of the guest, no refund or adjustment in future travel will be possible. The whole amount shall be treated as forfeited.
- In case of termination of tour by the guest, for any reasons, no refund or adjustment for future travel will be possible. The amount for unused portion of the tour shall be treated as forfeited. Amendment is only possible under the circumstances like Natural Disaster / Natural Calamity or Serious Health Problem's (this needs to be supported by doctor's certificate) and is subject to availability. No refunds are possible and every case be decided on merits on a case to case basis.
