Description

Each Takht represents a significant aspect of Sikh heritage, offering pilgrims a chance to connect deeply with their faith and history.

Takht Sri Hazur Sahib – Located in Nanded, Maharashtra, this Takht is where Guru Gobind Singh Ji passed away and is known for its beautiful gurdwara.

Takht Sri Patna Sahib – Situated in Patna, Bihar, this is the birthplace of Guru Gobind Singh Ji, the tenth Sikh Guru.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Hyderabad

On your arrival at Hyderabad airport, meet our representative & he will provide an assisted transfer to the prebooked hotel in Hyderabad. Overnight stay in Hyderabad

In the morning after breakfast, check out and transfer to Nanded by road. Arrive and check in at the hotel. Later visit **Sri Hazur Sahib**. Hazur Sahib is a sacred monument that houses one of the five takhts or thrones of temporal authority. Also famous as Abchalnagar and Takht Sachkhand Sri Hazur Sahib, Hazur Sahib is a renowned location for Sikh Pilgrimage. This is where Guru Gobind Singh breathed his last in 1708. The temple or the Gurudwara was built around the location where Guru Gobind Singh was cremated. The stunning architecture of the Gurudwara is quite a treat to the eyes and so is the complex that extends around it on the banks of River Godavari in Nanded, Maharashtra. In the evening attend Hazur Sahib Aarti and Shastra Darshan at Hazur Sahib & Later enjoy Sikh Guru History Laser Show at Gobind bagh. The show typically narrates the life and teachings of Guru Gobind Singh Ji, highlighting significant events and the rich history of Sikhism. It's a beautiful experience that combines visuals, sound, and spiritual reflection, usually held in the evening. Visitors are encouraged to check the exact timings and availability before planning their visit, as schedules may vary. After Guru Ka Langer. Overnight Stay at Nanded.

Day 3: Nanded (At Leisure)

Post breakfast, you will have day free at leisure or visit the local gurudwaras. Overnight stay in Nanded.

Day 4: Nanded - Bidar - Hyderabad

Post breakfast, you will drive to **Gurudwara Sri Nanak Jhira Sahib** in Bidar, which would take approximately 4 hours to reach by road. After darshan, continue your journey back to Hyderabad. Upon arrival in Hyderabad, stay at the hotel. Overnight stay in Hyderabad.

Day 5: Hyderabad - Patna (By Flight)

Later, check out from the hotel and get transferred to Hyderabad airport to board the flight to Patna. Prospering along the southern banks of river Ganges and set in the backdrop of a glorious historical past, Patna boasts of a dominating presence in history and enjoys the distinction of being one of the oldest cities in the world. In addition to being one of the major and most popular tourist destinations in India, this capital city of Bihar also holds significant religious and spiritual importance as it is a gateway to pilgrimage sites of Hindus, Sikhs, Jains and Buddhists. Upon arrival at Patna, meet our representative and get transfer to the prebooked hotel. Then, visit **Harmandir Takht Shri Patna Sahib**, popularly known as Patna Sahib Gurudwara is one of the holiest pilgrimages for the Sikh community. Located on the banks of the holy Ganga, this Gurudwara in Patna, Bihar was built commemorating the tenth Guru of Sikhs, Shri Guru Gobind Singh. The Gurudwara is regarded as the epicenter of Sikhism in Eastern India. Patna Sahib Gurudwara is the second acknowledged and accepted Takht of the five all total Takhts of Sikhism, which means 'seat of authority. -A morning prayer called ardaas is being performed here every morning at 5:45 A.M and evening prayer at 6:00 P.M. The langar or free food service is offered here to all the visitors. Stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 6: Patna (At Leisure)

Post breakfast, you will have day free at leisure or visit the local gurudwaras. Overnight stay in Patna.

Day 7: Patna - Delhi (By Flight)

After breakfast, check out and get transferred to Patna airport to catch the flight to Delhi. Upon your arrival at Delhi Airport, a driver will meet you for a smooth transfer to your hotel, featuring some sightseeing along the way. Start with a visit to Gurudwara Bangla Sahib, one of the most prominent Sikh temples in Delhi, known for its beautiful architecture and peaceful ambiance. After that, head to Gurudwara Rakab Ganj Sahib, which commemorates the martyrdom of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji. Enjoy a traditional langar meal at one of the gurdwaras before continuing your journey. Finally, stop by Connaught Place for a brief exploration of shops and cafés before transferring to your hotel.

Day 8: Departure

After breakfast, the day will be free at leisure. You can shop around or visit the local markets/cafes by walk. Later get assisted transfer to Delhi airport for your flight back to home.
